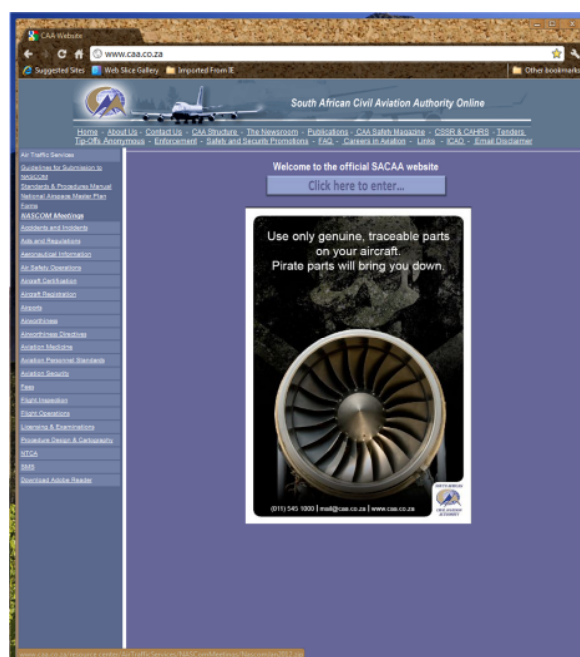
Report on NASCOM 2011 Meeting No. 5 of 9 February 2012 held at SACAA Midrand.
